- Terms/conditions agreements with no responsibility for corporations, no protection for consumers
- Job advertisements that do not accurately reflect compensation and requirements

Quite the opposite, our idea is to uphold all of these groups and see if we can somehow work together. Lately a consensus is becoming harder to ignore, the consensus that capitalism has tipped the scales into unsustainable territory. Unions and immigration have some interests that intersect: fair working conditions. Let's work together.

To that end the incoming administration has given our small group a cornucopia of ideas and we're going to set about arranging a mock-up. We will keep posted here as the concept fills out.
